

## By car

On the E313 motorway take exit 27 "Hasselt West." At the end of the exit you choose right for Hasselt center. Continue straight on the Kuringersteenweg. Cross the large boulevard (on your left is the supermarket Carrefour) and keep following the Kuringersteenweg and the Koningin Astridlaan. Follow this road to the small boulevard around Hasselt. Turn right and keep following this road. Successively drive on the Schiervellaan, the Leopold Square and Guffenslaan until you see the Kolonel Dusartplein on your right side. Under this square there is a parking lot. The Jenevermuseum is nearby the square and the parking lot, in the partially pedestrianized street behind the Provincial Library.

## By train

You leave the railway station and enter the Bampslaan. Take right and walk this street all the way to the end. Cross the boulevard and walk through the Ridder Portmansstraat and de Havermarkt to the Grote Markt. Here you turn turn left into the Hoogstraat. Keep following the Hoogstraat and the Demerstraat. Near the end of the Demerstraat choose the Witte Nonnenstraat on your right side. Walk 50 meters and you see the Jenevermuseum on your right.

This walk will take approximately 20 minutes.
